In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the 30 day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

Schedule A (Contributions & Other Receipts) contains four entries with the notation "undisclosed" that are greater than \$10 each

K.S.A. 25-4154(b) states, "No person shall give or accept any contribution in excess of \$10 unless the name and address of the contributor is known to the individual receiving the contribution."

If these were small contributions shown as a total, or if the campaign does know the contributors and intended to list the contribution as 'unitemized' rather than 'anonymous/undisclosed', **that fact must be disclosed in a letter of amendment to the report.**

****If these were single donations of greater than \$10, and the campaign is unaware of the names of the donor(s) of this \$125 total, the campaign must make a \$125 contribution to a non-political source, i.e., a charitable organization. That contribution should be listed on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 30, 2017, Receipt & Expenditure Report as an Anonymous Contribution correction.**
